Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

What does the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary celebrate?

On August 15, the Church celebrates the fact that Mary, the Mother of God, was assumed into Heaven at the end of her earthly life. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 974) teaches, "The Most Blessed Virgin Mary, when the course of her earthly life was completed, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven, where she already shares in the glory of her Son's Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of his Body."

What does the Assumption of Mary Teach Us?

In a homily for the Assumption, Pope St. John Paul II said, "Taken up into Heaven, Mary shows us the way to God, the way to Heaven, the way to life. She shows it to her children baptized in Christ and to all people of good will. She opens this way especially to the little ones and to the poor, those who are dear to divine mercy. The Queen of the world reveals to individuals and to nations the power of the love of God..."

God's Warrior Queen

Today on this marvelous Solemnity of the Assumption of the Virgin, we celebrate Mary's Assumption, body and soul, into heaven. This does not mean that she has gone away; she is a warrior, involved in the struggle against evil from a new vantage point.
