

**Sanctity of Life Sunday, January 18, 2026**

We stand for the sanctity of human life. The phrase “sanctity of life” reflects the belief that, because people are made in God’s image (Gen 1:26–27), human life has an inherently sacred attribute that should be protected and respected at all times. The sanctity of life means that humanity is more sacred than the rest of creation.

Humanity was created in God’s image, but sin has corrupted that image. There is nothing inherently sacred in fallen man. The sanctity of human life is not due to the fact that we are such wonderful and good beings. The only reason the sanctity of life applies to humanity is the fact that God created us in His image and set us apart from all other forms of life.

Sunday, January 18th is set aside as a special day of celebrate the sanctity of life and stand opposition to the culture of death, promoted by the abortion industry. We will consider with the holy church every effort to protect human life from harm—whether from abortion, euthanasia, human trafficking, or other abuses. While the sanctity of life can be the foundation, love must be the motivation.

## Proposed Restrictions on Religious Freedom – Bill C-9

The President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, Most Rev. Pierre Goudreault, has written to Prime Minister Mark Carney and other members of government concerning an amendment to Canada's hate speech legislation. The Liberal Party has made an agreement with the Bloc Québécois. In exchange for the BQ's support of Bill C-9, the Liberals will amend Section 319 (3) (b) of the Criminal Code to remove the religious exemption clause, which provides an exemption against prosecution for hate speech "if, in good faith, the person expressed or attempted to establish by an argument an opinion on a religious subject or an opinion based on a belief in a religious text."


