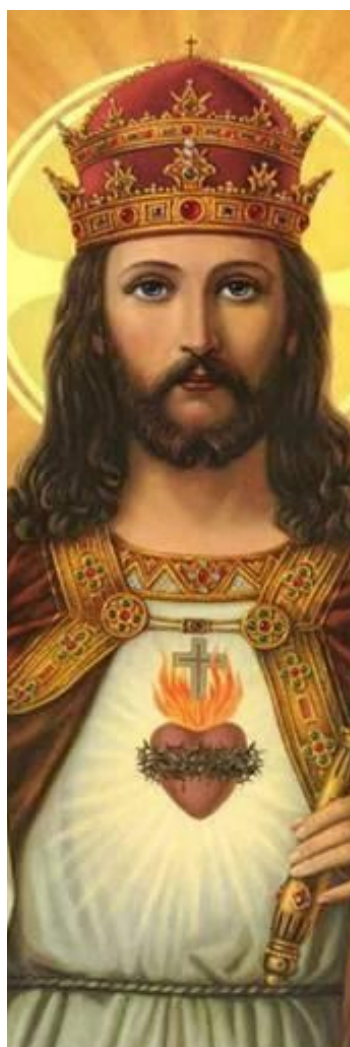

Travelling Statue of Mary



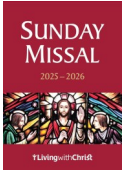
