Diocesan Annual Appeal



A successful Appeal furthers the mission of our local Church and of our parish and helps others in our diocese with the resources they truly need. Please consider your support in the coming week. Not everyone can make the same pledge, but if we all offer our sacrifice, we will truly be successful.

In addition to our diocesan appeal, the bishops of B.C. have asked us to help support efforts to promote healing and reconciliation between indigenous and non-indigenous peoples through a separate appeal. The diocese has been asked to pledge \$147,000 toward this important work. Over the past two years, we raised \$110,000 of that total. We do not set parish goals for this appeal, but look to the generosity of everyone to make a meaningful contribution to support these efforts.

The Healing and Reconciliation Committee has been formed and has begun meeting. Four indigenous members will review and consider how best to use the funds raised in our diocese to support projects that promote healing and reconciliation.
