Appointed Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops and President of the Pontifical Commission for Latin America

Sept. 30, 2023 Created Cardinal by Pope Francis, assigned the Deaconry of Santa Monica

May 8, 2025 Elected the 267th Pope, taking the name Leo XIV – the first American pope in history
