6:30pm. During the season of Advent, we look forward to welcoming Jesus, our Emmanuel, the gift of God with us. In preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we examine various aspects of our lives, considering the many gifts God has given us, and how we have responded. Please take advantage of this opportunity to prepare your heart for the coming of the Christ child this Christmas.

Examination of Conscience:

THE GIFT OF FAITH:

Do I trust in God? Are there times when I despair?

Do I pray daily, taking time to praise God?

Am I mindful of all God has given me? How am I responding to the call to share my faith with others, to lead others to Christ?

Do I participate in the Eucharist as an act of praise and thanksgiving? Does the time I spend with God show that God is a priority in my life?

Do I treat myself with respect? Do I take care of my body, my health? Do I treat the gift of sexuality - mine and others' - with appropriate dignity?

Am I careful about how I 'feed' my body, my mind, my heart?
