All Saints' Day

Saturday, November 1

Holy Mass at 9:00am

All Saints Day is celebrated on November 1 in the Roman Catholic Church. On this day, the Church honors all saints, both those formally canonized and others who have attained heaven (see Heb. 12:22-24). These saints are individuals who have lived lives of extraordinary faith and dedication to God, serving as role models for Christians. Whether officially recognized by the Church or not, these [saints](#) have played a significant role in spreading Christianity and leading others toward holiness (Matt. 28:18-20).

Blessing of Graves Sunday, November 2 at 1:00pm

The month of November is dedicated to honouring and praying for the dead. Everyone is welcome to gather and pray for the departed and for the blessing of graves on November 2nd at 1:00pm at the Terrace Municipal Cemetery.

The *Catechism* reminds us that: "From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. As the renowned Father of the Church St. John Chrysostom tells us, "Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them." The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead.
