### November is the Month of All Souls and All Saints

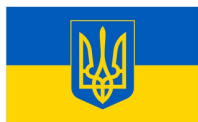

### The War in Ukraine: A Call to Prayer, Fasting, and Action



The Ukrainian Catholic Bishops of Canada have released a pastoral letter inviting the people to pray, fast and act in support of their brothers and sisters in Ukraine.

**In particular, they invite the faithful to a 3-day fast from November 24 to November 26<sup>th</sup> 2022.** These dates commemorate the Holodomor Ukrainian Famine of 1932 to 1933, when many Ukrainians, like those suffering from the war today, had no food.

If you wish to make a monetary donation to Ukraine you may make it through the parish by clearly marking your envelope with your name, address and "Ukraine" or, if donating by e-transfer, please put "Ukraine" in the memo line of your donation.
