Canada's 2021 Euthanasia Report. More than 10,000 Deaths

Canada's 2021 Euthanasia Report stated that there were: **10,064 assisted deaths in 2021** up from 7603 in 2020.



Approximately 1740 euthanasia deaths were based on loneliness and isolation. Other reasons for euthanasia included poverty and lack of support for health conditions. Please show love towards your family and your neighbour, especially those who are most vulnerable, by giving them your time, presence, aid and compassion.
