Diocesan Annual Appeal



Today is the Educational and Promotional Weekend for Called Together – Giving, Sharing, Serving. As in the past, your pledge truly benefits the small parishes, missions and ministries throughout our diocese. A successful Appeal furthers the mission of our local Church and of our parish and helps others in our diocese with the resources they truly need. Not everyone can make the same pledge, but if we all offer our sacrifice, we will truly be successful. Please pick up your Appeal envelope after Mass today.

Our Parish Goal is: \$ 31, 619.00

To date we have collected: \$833.00

In addition to our diocesan appeal, the bishops of B.C. have asked us to help support efforts to promote healing and reconciliation between indigenous and non-indigenous peoples through a separate appeal. The diocese has been asked to pledge \$147,000 toward this important work. Last year, we raised half of that amount. We do not set parish goals for this appeal, but look to the generosity of everyone to make a meaningful contribution to support these efforts.
