A prayer box for your intentions will be available during the week and Fr. James will pray for these intentions during Adoration.

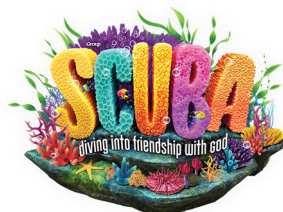
Mass Time Change Saturday, May 4th Saturday evening Mass on 4th of May: 6:00pm
