The Besners of Prince Rupert donated property for the first Catholic Church in Terrace.






#### **The Besners**


Olier Besner was one of the many intrepid French-Canadians who stampeded to the Klondike and for 10 years there handled the pick and shovel, at first for others, until he had made a stake, and then working his own ground.

He came to Prince Rupert in July, 1908 and married Madame Artaud, of the Old Knox Hotel Prominent among the women pioneers of Prince Rupert is Mrs. Olier Besner, who built the Old Knox Hotel and also the New Knox Hotel, the latter the first notable landmark of the city that strikes the attention of the visitors coming in by steamer. Mrs. Besner, originally from San Francisco, was in the great stampede to the Klondike in the spring of 1908, braving all the hardships of those first golden-fleece Argonauts over the dreaded Chilkoot Pass. In 1915, Mrs. Besner bought some property in Terrace. She later donated this property for the first Catholic Church on Lakelse Avenue











In 1936 Father Champagne built a small school next to the church. The structure was later converted to a rectory in 1940 by Father Fabre.



### **Veritas School**

An 8 room classroom school was opened in the Fall of 1959 under the direction of Father Mohan. Veritas School, the Latin word for Truth, was named by Father Oliver Mohan.

The Sisters of St Joseph of Toronto arrived to take charge of the new school in 1959 and a convent was built in 1960.

The school was staffed for many years by the Sisters of St. Joseph and Frontier Apostles. Frontier Apostles came to Northern B. C. from all over the world to build and staff Catholics schools.

In 1988 The Sisters of St Joseph left the diocese.

As the population in Terrace grew and the downtown core evolved, Sacred Heart Parish expanded.

In 1972 the church property was sold and a part of Veritas School and the convent were relocated from Lakelse Ave to the present location on Straume Ave.

Father Allison said there was a group of people who were interested in moving the old church from its present site and preserving it elsewhere. Unfortunately the church was built in several different sections and would have been extremely difficult to move.

The old church remained on Lakelse until the new property owners disposed of it.
