I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.

I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.

Sinners will find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.

Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.

Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.

I will bless every place in w/c an image of my Heart is exposed and honored.

I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.

Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in my Heart.

I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. ## CCCB Statement for the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Legalisation of Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide (“MAiD”)

The Standing Committee For Family and Life of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) has issued a statement marking the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the legalisation of euthanasia and assisted suicide in Canada. Bill C-14, which legalised euthanasia and assisted suicide under the term “MAiD”, was passed on June 17, 2016. In its statement, the CCCB offers statistics and concerns about the continued expansion of “MAiD” and its impact on vulnerable Canadians.
